- Law School concentrations indicate focused coursework and experiential learning or independent research in a particular area of study beyond the required curriculum. Students who complete the concentration will receive a notation on their Law School transcript.
- A student may declare a maximum of two concentrations.
- Each concentration requires successful independent completion of (1) two or more foundational courses, (2) three or more approved courses, and (3) an experiential course or a paper approved by the Vice Dean.
- A single course or experience may not count as satisfying two concentrations.
- A student may use a single course to satisfy the six credits experiential learning requirement *and* the selected concentration's group C experiential course option.
- A student should refer to the [University Catalog](#) and Degree Works for published concentration requirements.
- Students may not submit this form before Add/Drop ends in their *final* semester.
- Attach any approvals from the Vice Dean for independent research, student notes, and courses approved on an ad hoc basis.
- Submission deadlines:
 - May Graduate: no earlier than 2nd week of spring classes, but no later than **Feb 1**
 - Aug Graduate: no earlier than 2nd week of spring classes, but no later than **May 1**
 - Dec Graduate: no earlier than 2nd week of fall classes, but no later **Sept 1**
