- Each concentration requires successful independent completion of (1) two or more foundational courses, (2) three or more approved courses, and (3) an independent research paper or an experiential course.
- A single course or experience may not count as satisfying two concentrations.
- A student may use a single course to satisfy the six credits experiential learning requirement *and* the selected concentration's group C experiential course option.
- A student should refer to the University Catalog and Degree Works for published concentration requirements.
