

Multinational

[Fulbright Foreign Student Program](#)

If you are from one of the listed countries, you may be eligible to apply for the Fulbright Foreign Student Program. This is open for graduate students, young professionals, and creative people. Application and deadlines vary by country.

[Aga Khan Foundation International Scholarship Programme](#)

Students must be nationals of the following countries who are interested in development-related studies and have no other means of financing their education: Bangladesh, India, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan, Syria, Egypt, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Madagascar and Mozambique. Preference is given to those under 30, and half of the scholarship is considered a loan with a 5% interest rate.

[MPOWER Global Citizen Scholarship](#)

Open to international students who want to study in the U.S. or Canada, that are accepted at or enrolled in a full-time degree program. There is a grand prize, runner-up prize, and honorable mention.

[P.E.O. International Peace Scholarship](#)

Available for women from other countries pursuing graduate studies in the United States or Canada. Applicants must include with application an accounting of additional financial resources that would be used to help meet estimated expenses.

[Flywire Charitable Foundation Academic Scholarships](#)

Scholarships for students across chosen themes, most recently social justice, global health, and global citizenship. Eligibility is for all graduate and undergraduate students worldwide pursuing all majors.

[Margaret McNamara Education Grants](#)

Full-time students with a visa are eligible to apply. Students should self-identify as women and at least 25 years old. Students must be nationals of eligible countries and enrolled in an accredited academic institution.

Belgium

[Graduate Study Fellowships](#)

For Belgian holders of a Bachelor's degree who wish to obtain an initial two-year Master's degree in the United States. Applicants also have a minimum TOEFL and GRE score.

Colombia

[COLFUTURO Scholarship Credit Program](#)

For students from Colombia, it allows students to obtain a loan for graduate or doctoral studies, and then possibly earn back up to 80% in scholarship if the student returns to Columbia and works there for three years after finishing their degree.

Georgia

[International Education Center](#)

Scholarships available for Georgian citizens wishing to study abroad, and funding is available for approximately 200 students per year. Applications vary depending on the program.

Hong Kong

[Sir Edward Youde Memorial Fellowships for Overseas Studies](#)

For students who plan on living and working in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region after graduation. Applicants must be permanent residents of Hong Kong who speak both English and Chinese, have Honors degrees, and received at least seven years of continuous full-time education in Hong Kong. The scholarship may last for up to three years.

India

[Inlaks Shivdasani Scholarships](#)

Scholarships for Indian students to pursue a full-time Masters, M.Phil or Doctorate program. It is open to Indian citizens with a high first-class degree without a postgraduate qualification. Scholarships awards vary.

[K.C. Mahindra Scholarships for Post-Graduate Studies Abroad](#)

Open to Indian students who have a First-Class degree or equivalent and have secured or applied for admission in foreign universities. Scholarship amounts vary, and cannot be for undergraduate studies, seminars, or conferences.

[J.N. Tata Endowment for the Higher Education of Indians](#)

Loan scholarship for studies abroad for postgraduate/Ph.D./Postdoctoral/Research fellowship studies. Candidates should be less than 45 years old, and can apply before or after admission to an international institution.

Japan

[College Women's Association of Japan Scholarships](#)

There are three applicable scholarships for LLM students. First, a [Graduate Scholarship for Japanese Women to Study Abroad](#). Student must be living in Japan, have a minimum TOEFL score, and be accepted into an English degree program where they will be an in-person student. Second, a [Scholarship for the Visually Impaired](#). Students must have a certificate of disability, grade 1-6, as well as a minimum TOEFL score and be Japanese nationals living in Japan.

Korea

[Government Scholarship for Overseas Study](#)

Scholarships are available for master's and doctoral degrees for two years in the United States. Up to 70 students will be chosen, and there are assessments and interviews, as well as an application. Scholarship amounts can vary.

Mexico

[Fund for Development of Human Resources](#)

Scholarship is open to Mexican nationals for specialty, master, or doctoral studies. Calls for applications are on the main website, and you can apply up to six months after starting your program. Applicants should be under fifty years old, have an acceptance letter from their preferred program and proof of knowledge of a second language.

Norway

[NORAM Graduate Scholarship](#)

Scholarships for Norwegian citizens for graduate studies in the United States. Up to 35 scholarships awarded each year. Scholarships are for students who want to complete a minimum of three-months of a masters or PhD in the United States, and your degree can have already begun. Scholarships do not have a retroactive effect.

Saudi Arabia

[Excellence Scholarship Path](#)

Scholarships for Saudi students with good conduct and behavior for use in attaining non-executive masters or doctoral degrees. Students must be studying in the country where the program is located, outside of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
