

Website Ranks Law Review as 20th Most-Cited Legal Periodical; Specialty Journals Rank Among Top Ten Most-Cited in Their Fields

A website at Washington and Lee University recently posted journal rankings for the years 2000-2007. Under citations (“Total cites to the journal over an 8-year period from journal articles”):

The *William and Mary Law Review* ranked as the 20th most-cited journal among more than 1,000 U.S. and selected non-U.S. legal periodicals.

The *William & Mary Bill of Rights Journal* ranked as the 4th most-cited constitutional law journal.

The *William and Mary Environmental Law and Policy Review* ranked as the 9th most-cited environmental, natural resources and land use law journal.

The *William and Mary Journal of Women and the Law* ranked as the 3rd most-cited law journal for gender, sexuality, and women’s issues.
