Online Law Non-Degree Policies

- Status is granted for one semester only; a new application must be filed for each term.
- William and Mary Law School retains the right to deny enrollment in specific courses based on space availability.
- All non-degree students must comply with the Law School's online programs policies including policies regarding student conduct.
- Non-degree students (whether students of the College of William and Mary or of another institution) enrolled in a degree program and who request that earned credits be applied to their degree must present a letter of good standing from their dean which also states that the credits earned at College of William and Mary School of Law will be applied to the student's degree.

Transferability of Non-Degree Courses

Per the Law School's accrediting body standards, the American Bar Association (ABA), coursework offered as part of the Master of Legal Studies (MLS) degree program cannot be transferred or count toward a JD should you ultimately begin a Law program at William & Mary Law School, nor any other ABA Law School.
